Agenda Item No.4: LETTER FROM KOZHIKODE MAYOR TO ENGAGE KMRL FOR URBAN TRANSPORT PROJECT IN KOZHIKODE CORPORATION

The Hon. Mayor – Kozhikode, in his letter EG21/69416/17 dated 19.12.2017, requested to engage KMRL for Urban Transport project in Kozhikode, with centage fees as 5% of the approved project cost and advance payment for the execution of work as 20% of the contractors project cost. Therefore, the Kozhikode Corporation was requesting permission to go ahead with signing the contract agreement with KMRL followed by DPR preparation and implementation of the project.

Decision:

SHPSC approved the decision of engaging KMRL for the Urban transport and Parks projects in the cities of Kochi and Kozhikode as per the following:

- 1. Centage charges for end to end support, to be 5% of the total project cost, as per G.O. 61/2017/Fin dated 09/05/2017.
- 2. Advance payment, to be 20% of the awarding project cost as per G.O. 311/14/Fin dated 30/07/2014.

Action taken:

The agreements in both cities have been executed and signed. Sri. Mohammed Hanish, I.A.S, Managing Director, KMRL vide letter No. KMRL/PRJ/AMRUT/320/2017/2717 dated 24.01.2018 .informed that the preparation of DPRs for the above projects will be completed by the first week of March 2018, ensuring that all entrusted projects will be finished within the SAAP duration.

Agenda Item No.A1: Kollam Municipal Corporation: Letter from Hon'ble Mayor - Implementation of the Sewage Treatment Plant (AMRUT) Project and completion of balance components in networks and commissioning of sewerage system by KWA.

Vide Lr. No. CSSS1 (PW13)/48036/15 dated 27.12.2017, The Hon'ble Mayor, Kollam Municipal Corporation has requested to entrust KWA for the implementation of the proposed STP at Kureepuzha and completion of balance components and commissioning of sewerage system.

Decision:

SHPSC has taken the following decisions:

- KWA may implement the project of STP and associated components of sewer networks on assurance by the Kollam Municipal Corporation that they will surmount all local issues.
- DPR to be presented in the next SLTC

Action taken:

The DPR for STP at Kureepuzha recommended for AS in 17th SLTC held on 25.01.2018 and will be presented in this SHPSC.

Agenda Item No. A.2:Guruvayur Municipality core committee decision –Transfer of Fund to Water supply scheme.

In the 16th SLTC, Chairperson of Guruvayur Municipality requested that, out of the 14.5Cr SAAP amount under sewerage and septage sector, an amount of Rs.10.0Cr may be transferred to Water Supply for Laying distribution Networks in the Thykkad Zone and the remaining Rs. 4.5 Cr. may be utilized for a decentralized Septage Treatment Plant. Based on the above discussions, the 16th SLTC decided that if land is available, a de-centralized septage plant shall be proposed for 4.5 Cr, the remaining amount of Rs. 10.00 Cr. will be transferred to water supply scheme, subject to final approval by SHPSC

Decision:

SHPSC has approved the following:

- Proposal of Guruvayur Municipality to transfer Rs. 10.00cr. from Sewerage Sector to Water Supply Sector to carry out the Project – Laying distribution Networks in the Thykkad Zone.
- Utilization of balance amount of Rs. 4.50 cr. for decentralised septage treatment plant.
- DPRs to be presented in the next SLTC

Action taken:

- 1. DPR for Water Supply project is presented in the 17th SLTC held on 25.01.2018 and is recommended for AS in this SHPSC.
- 2. Letter issued to MD, KWA requesting assistance for taking up an agenda in the upcoming KWA board meeting for issuing Permissive sanction for 50 cents of land to Guruvayur Municipality,.

Minutes of the 14th State Level High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) of Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) held on 29th December 2017 in the Committee Room of the Chief Secretary, Government of Kerala.

The meeting of the 14th State Level High Powered Steering Committee (SHPSC) of AMRUT chaired by Dr. K.M. Abraham IAS, Chief Secretary, Government of Kerala, commenced at 03.00 pm. (List of Participants enclosed as Annexure I)

Sri Shajan S., Project Manager of AMRUT, presented the points in the agenda notes. After detailed deliberations, following decisions were made.

Agenda Item No. 1. Approval of the minutes of the 13th meeting of SHPSC

Decision: The Committee approved the minutes of 13th meeting of SHPSC held on 14th December 2017.

Agenda Item No. 2. Action taken report on the decisions of the 13th meeting of SHPSC held on 14th December 2017

The Committee noted the Action Taken Report on the decisions of the 13th SHPSC held on 14th December 2017. The Committee has also given its additional decisions on the Action taken report on the following items.

AGENDA & DECISION 2.3: Energy Audit for Water Systems

As part of AMRUT reforms, the Ministry of Urban Development has directed to take the support of Energy Efficiency Systems Limited (EESL) to conduct energy audit of water pumping systems and replace inefficient pumps in all AMRUT cities. SHPSC observed the need for the energy audit and pointed that the assets of water supply systems is owned by KWA hence the energy audit of the nine AMRUT cities has to be steered by KWA. The contract agreement between KWA, Mission Directorate and EESL has to be finalized and signed up at the earliest.

The Chairman directed Secretary, Water Resources department to expedite the signing of agreement between Kerala Water Authority, EESL and Mission Directorate for conducting energy audit. The Mission Director vide Ltr No.14/17/SMMU/PM dated 23.10.2017 requested to the Managing Director of Kerala Water Authority to expedite the issue. A meeting was arranged by the Principal



Secretary, LSGD on 4th November 2017 attended by Mission Director, AMRUT, Kerala Water Authority and EESL, in which MD, KWA has agreed that the draft of the tripartite agreement will be issued within 4 days to Principal Secretary, with copies to all parties of the agreement. A reminder letter was also issued to KWA on 24.11.2017. As per the SHPSC directions to submit immediately the draft agreement, KWA submitted it, to Mission Directorate on 15.12.2017.

Action taken: The draft agreement received from KWA was forwarded to EESL, vide letter SMMU/A/14/2015/UIE dated 16.12.2017 for review and concurrence. Reply from EESL is received on 28.12.2017 vide lr. EESL/MoUD/AMRUT/KL/02.

Additional Decision: The comments of EESL to be forwarded to KWA and finalize the agreement and initiate signature process at the earliest.

The SHPSC took note of the action taken report on other items of 13thSHPSC meeting.



Agenda Item No.4: LETTER FROM KOZHIKODE MAYOR TO ENGAGE KMRL FOR URBAN TRANSPORT PROJECT IN KOZHIKODE CORPORATION

The Hon. Mayor - Kozhikode, in his letter EG21/69416/17 dated 19.12.2017, replied that the above concerns raised in the SHPSC has been conveyed to KMRL and obtained their willingness for centage fees as 5% of the approved project cost and advance payment for the execution of work as 20% of the contractors project cost. Therefore, the Kozhikode Corporation is requesting the Mission Director for permission to go ahead with signing the contract agreement with KMRL followed by DPR preparation and implementation of the project.

The topic has been placed in the 15th SLTC held on 22.12.2017 and the SLTC Chairman informed that a discussion is made with the Managing Director, KMRL and sought acceptance to take up the Urban Transport and Parks projects in Kochi and Kozhikode Corporations as per the Finance GO stipulations for Centage services (GO No. 61/2017/Fin dated 9.5.2017).


Decision:

SHPSC approved the following for the Urban transport and Parks projects in the cities of Kochi and Kozhikode entrusted to KMRL:

- Centage charges for end to end support, to be 5% of the total project cost, as per G.O. 61/2017/Fin dated 09/05/2017.
- Advance payment, to be 20% of the awarding project cost as per G.O. 311/14/Fin dated 30/072014.

Agenda Item No.A1: Kollam Municipal Corporation: Letter from Hon'ble Mayor - Implementation of the Sewage Treatment Plant (AMRUT) Project and completion of balance components in networks and commissioning of sewerage system by KWA.

> Vide Lr. No. CSSS1 (PW13)/48036/15 dated 27.12.2017, the Hon'ble Mayor, Kollam Municipal Corporation requested the Mission Directorate to obtain sanction from SLTC to entrust KWA for the



implementation of the proposed STP at Kureepuzha and completion of balance components and commissioning of sewerage system, as KWA is fully familiar with the status, issues related to the sewerage projects, being worked with KSUDP sewerage scheme under ADB fund and having a Project implementation Unit (PIU) exclusively for the sewerage projects).


The observations of 16th SLTC in this regard, are the following:

- The STP project at Kureepuzha, was a project undertaken in KSUDP through ADB funding in 2013 and was dropped due to public protest. Therefore, Kollam Corporation has to provide the action taken reports and interventions made in the mitigation of public agitations in the project location and demonstrate the extent of public protest as per the current scenario.
- Moreover, the Corporation states that land has been transferred to KWA and all clearances were obtained. However, the details of land transfer, types of clearances obtained etc.. are not indicated in the letter.
- Also, the willingness of KWA to execute the project is not mentioned in the reference letter. Therefore, the KWA's acceptances for implementation of the project need to be clarified and confirmed.
- In addition, in the 9th SHPSC meeting it was decided that all sewerage projects except Trivandrum and Kochi Elamkulam need to be implemented by concerned ULBs. Hence, the Agenda items needs re-consideration and re-approval by SHPSC

Decision:

SHPSC took the following decisions:


- KWA may implement the project of STP and associated components of sewer networks on assurance by the Kollam Municipal Corporation that they will surmount all local issues including mitigation of public protest and local hindrances if any.
- Corporation is fully responsible to resolve all hindrances and effectively facilitate KWA for the accomplishment of the project



well within the AMRUT time limit. Responsibility shall be assigned to Mayor, Corporation Secretary, Corporation Engineering Team and CMMU along with the KWA project implementation wing from inception to completion.

- Land availability has to be confirmed, with whether adequate land is available, due to the enhancement of STP capacity from 12 MLD (designed under KSUDP Project) to 18 MLD.
- The Project implementation shall be conventional with Design and Construction. EPC mode is not approved. Tendering should be NCB, with 5 year O&M by the contractor. Thereafter Corporation should take over O&M. Construction shall be fully monitored to complete the project within the designated time frame of AMRUT.
- Two Septage treatment plant projects shall also be taken up directly by ULB for the areas not covered by sewerage network as per the approved SAAP. DPR preparation is to be initiated as per the ULB norms (selection of consultant if necessary).
- DPRs shall be presented in the next SLTC.

Agenda Item No. A.2: Guruvayur municipality core committee decision -transfer of fund to Water supply scheme.



In the 16th SLTC held on 28.12.2017 Chairperson of Guruvayur municipality stated that an amount of Rs.10.0 Cr may be transferred to Water Supply sector for laying distribution networks in the Thykkad zone. The remaining Rs. 4.5 Cr. may be utilized for a Septage Treatment Plant and the land will be finalized with KWA. For that, Principal Secretary insisted a combined inspection of land to be conducted by KWA officials (designated by Technical Member- KWA), Secretary and Engineers of ULB, CMMU Members and Environmental Expert from SMMU.

The Technical Member of KWA also ensured that the ongoing Guruvayur sewerage scheme will be commissioned before

April 2018 and KWA does not require any amount from AMRUT for the completion of their ongoing STP project.

Based on the above discussions, the 16th SLTC decided that if land is available, a Septage Treatment Plant shall be proposed for 4.5 Cr, the remaining amount of Rs. 10.00 Cr. can be transferred to water supply project, subject to final approval by SHPSC.

Decision:

The SHPSC approved the following:

- Proposal of Guruyayur Municipality to transfer Rs. 10.00cr. from Sewerage Sector to Water Supply Sector to carry out the Project – Laying distribution Networks in the Thykkad Zone.
- Utilization of balance amount of Rs. 4.50 cr. for Septage Treatment Plant.
- DPRs shall be presented to the next SLTC.

Agenda Item No. A.3:KWA PROJECTS - ALLOWING TENDER EXCESS

The Additional Agenda brought by KWA MD in which they stated that the recent 16 tenders opened in various AMRUT cities, 9 works are seen quoted above the estimate rate, 6 works below and one at estimate rate. The details are as follows:-

The tender excess ranges from 3% to 34 %. The reason for excess may be that the pipe line works are to be expected in the heart of the city where the roads are very much congested with heavy traffic, presence of other utility, need to work at night, anticipated delay in road permissions etc.


Mission Director, KWA informed that considering the nature of quotes and low participation in bids the possibility of getting better rates in a retender is remote. Hence in the interest of timely execution of the works, the SHPSC may please consider the possibility of allowing tender excess as the prevailing Government guide lines.

Decision:

- The SHPSC agreed to consider up to 10% tender excess and any excess beyond 10% shall be brought within this limit or else re-tendering shall be carried out urgently.
- KWA shall provide the total impact on the tender excess in the next SHPSC.

Agenda Item No. 5: ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION OF DPRS

In the 15th SLTC held on 22.12.2017, 22 DPRs amounting to Rs. 66.08 Cr were reviewed and recommended to be placed before the SHPSC to accord Administrative Sanction (AS).



In the 16th SLTC held on 28.12.2017, 49 DPRs amounting to Rs. 382.45 Cr were reviewed and recommended to be placed before the SHPSC to accord Administrative Sanction (AS). Thus total number of projects 71 DPRs amounting to Rs. 448.53 Cr are presented to SHPSC. List of projects attached as *Annexure-II* &


The SHPSC discussed the projects in detail and decided to accord Administrative Sanction to 71 projects amounting to Rs. 448.53 cr.



The meeting of State Level Technical Committee commenced at 11:00 am in the Chamber of Additional Chief Secretary, Local Self Government Department. List of participants is attached as *Annexure I*

Agenda Item No. 1.: Confirmation of the Minutes of the 16th SLTC held on 28.12.2017

Decision: The SLTC confirmed the Minutes of the 16th SLTC held on 28.12.2017.

Agenda Item No. 2.: Action taken report on the decisions of 16th meeting of SLTC

Agenda Item No. AA1: Kollam Municipal Corporation: Letter from Hon'ble Mayor to Sanction 1)New Storm Water Drainage Projects and 2)
Implementation of Sewage Treatment Project by KWA.

The Hon'ble Mayor, Kollam Municipal Corporation requested the SLTC to sanction for new DPRs in Storm Water Drainage 2017-18 phase III and allow implementation by Kerala Water Authority, of the Sewage Treatment Plant (under AMRUT project) and completion of balance components in networks and commissioning of sewerage system.

Decision:

SLTC took the decisions:

- 1. Transfer of savings from Urban Transport to Storm Water Drainage is not admissible as SWD is not a priority Sector.
- 2. Implementation of proposed STP at Kureepuzha through KWA to be taken up as an agenda item in the 14th SHPSC.

Action Taken: Decision no.2 has been presented in the 14th SHPSC held on 29.12.2017 and obtained approval for implementation of the project by KWA, on assurance by the Kollam Municipal Corporation to surmount all local issues and resolve all hindrances for accomplishment of the project in time.

Agenda Item No. 3: Approval of DPRs for recommendations to SHPSC.

The MMU received 49 projects amounting to Rs 382.45 Cr from seven mission cities viz. Thrissur, Alapuzha, Kochi, Thiruvananthapuram, Palakkad, Guruvayoor and Kannur.

Decision:

SLTC decided to recommend 49 projects amounting to Rs. 382.45 Cr. for the consideration of SHPSC

Action Taken: The recommended 49 projects amounting to Rs. 382.45 Cr. were placed in the 14th SHPSC meeting on 29.12.2017 and AS accorded to 71 projects amounting to Rs. 448.53 Cr. as per G.O. (Rt) No. 5/2018/LSGD dated 01.01.2018.

Decision: The Committee noted the Action Taken Report of the 16th SLTC meeting. It is also noted that the promise given to GoI in the meeting chaired by Secretary, Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, GoI that

works will be awarded at least in 25% projects in SAAP I (2015-16) and to issue 100% AS to AMRUT projects are not yet achieved by SMMU. Chairman expressed his deep displeasure to MD and team for this severe lapse.

Agenda Item No. 3: APPROVAL OF NEW PROJECTS DUE TO SECTOR CHANGES AND SAAP SAVINGS

The following ULBs have requested for approving new projects from savings either owing to sector changes or inclusion of new projects.

- 1. Vide letter no. E2-52024/15(1) dated 12.01.2018, Alappuzha Municipal Chairman requested to transfer the balance amount of 6.64 Cr. from the Sewerage Sector to Water Supply Sector for taking up new projects under WS sector.
- 2. Guruvayur Municipality requested to consider a new park project amounting to Rs. 28 lakhs at Choolppuram. The amount is resulted from the savings in parks sector projects.
- 3. Vide letter No. E13/133186/15 dated 22.01.2018, Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation requested to include 2 new projects ie, Water supply project 1 No @ 2.5 Cr. (Replacement of old and damaged pipeline of Trivandrum Water supply Scheme Phase II) and Sewerage project 1 No @ 0.353 Cr (Providing sewerage facilitate to newly constructed housing colony at Karimadom) incurred from SAAP savings.

Decisions taken:

- 1. Balance fund in sewerage / septage sector should be utilized in the same sector and can't be transferred to the water supply sector. Land for the septage treatment plant is to be identified out by Alappuzha municipality, to avoid the lapse of funds. Chairman also expressed his displeasure about non-representation from Alappuzha Municipality in the meeting.
- 2. Approved and DPR is presented in the SLTC meeting.
- 3. Approved and DPR is presented in the SLTC meeting.

Agenda Item No. 4: REQUEST FOR PROVIDING TABLET PCs FOR ALL WARD COUNCILORS OF THIRUVANANTHAPURAM MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

Vide letter No.E13/133186/15 dated 22.01.2018, the Secretary Thiruvananthapuram Municipal Corporation requested SLTC to consider the recommendation by the Corporation Council to buy tablets for all Councilors of Trivandrum Corporation (as part of their capacity building initiatives) from the "Reform incentive" amount of

2.09 Cr. The Estimated amount for 100 ward councilors @ 20,000/- per tablet will be amounting to Rs.20.0 lakhs.

Decisions taken: SLTC meeting concurred with the Mission Directorate's observation and informed that tablets are madmissible components as per AMRUT guidelines and the "reform incentive" award can only be used on admissible components of AMRUT including new projects, reform implementation and capacity Building initiatives. Therefore, ULB may meet such expenditure from their own fund.

Additional Agenda Item No. A1: LETTER FROM HON'BLE MAYOR, KOLLAM CORPORATION – 1). REQUEST FOR TRANSFER OF FUND OF RS. 38.15 CR FROM SEWERAGE AND URBAN TRANSPORT SECTOR TO WATER SUPPLY SECTOR 2). REQUEST FOR RECOMMENDATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION FOR 7 PARKS PENDING AT 9TH SLTC HELD ON 12 JULY 2017

The Hon'ble Mayor, Kollam presented the following topics:

- 1. The total un-utilized amount in Sewerage/Septage and UT Sector (35.64 + 2.15) of Rs. 38.15 Cr. to transfer to Water Supply Sector for the completion of comprehensive water supply scheme project for Kollam.
- 2. Administrative sanction for 7 parks which had been pending with 9th SLTC (held on 12.07.2017) for submitting consent from the concerned departments such as ownership documents, clearance certificate required from Revenue, NH and PWD.

Decisions taken:
