AGENDA NO. 2 CONSTITUTION OF TECHNICAL EXPERT COMMITTEE FOR ISSUING TECHNICAL SANCTION

The 2nd HPSC meeting held on 19-04-2016had decided that the technical sanction for the projects in the financial year 2015-16 shall be accorded by the respective departments. For projects under Water supply and sewerage sectors, , Kerala Water Authority is authorized to issue the TS. For Storm water drainage, Urban Transport, Green Space and Parks sectors, the LSGD Engineering Wing is authorized to issue TS.

The Third High Powered Steering Committeemeeting held on 3-7-2016 had decided that henceforth, a Technical Expert Committee has to be constituted to issue the technical sanctions of projects under AMRUT.

Two technical committees may be constituted empanelling five experts each. The first Committee may vet the projects under Water Supply, Sewerage and Septage, Storm Water Drainage sectors and the second committee to scrutinize projects under Urban Transport and Green Space & Parks sectors.

Point for decision: The committee may decide the structure of the Expert Committees& the experts to be included for each sector.

AGENDA NO. 3ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION OF DPRS OF THRISSUR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION

All mission cities have to prepared the SLIPs for five categories. SLIPs for the sectors Water Supply and Sewerage were prepared by KWA, while for Urban Transport, Storm water drainage and Parks /Open spaces by the Engineering Division of the ULB.

Point for decision :The committee may review the SLIP and recommend the SLIPs for SHPSC's approval

AGENDA NO.5 : ULB-WISE ALLOCATION 2016-17

Vide D.O No.K-14012/95/2015/AMRUT/I dated 06-06-2016 of the MoUD.Central Assistance for the year 2016 -17 is Rs.386.4 Cr, and the corresponding State plus ULB share is also an equal amount of Rs. 386.4 Cr.

Therefore the State Annual Action Plan for 2016-17 has to be prepared for Rs 772.8 Cr. The amount has to be distributed among the mission cities. The criteria adopted for fund allocationare as follows
