Agenda Item No.7.3: ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION FOR THE SEWERAGE PROJECT OF KOLLAM & KOCHI CORPORATIONS (SWAP-2):

9th SLTC Decision:

❖ The Managing Director of KWA was directed to take the necessary steps to issue the TS for the Kochi Sewerage project. MD KWA agreed to issue the same within a week.

Action Taken:

TS for Kochi sewerage project is yet to be issued.

Agenda Item No. 7.8: OPENING OF SEPARATE BANK ACCOUNT FOR MAINTAINING THE EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) AND PROCESSING FEE AT SNA:

9th SLTC Decision:

Agenda Item No. 7.9: To entrust the IMPACT KERALA with the task of implementing STP/FSTP schemes for the ULBs that are unable to do so far.

9th SLTC Decision:

- ❖ The Mission Director reported that IMPACT Kerala has only a skeleton structure consisting of two project managers who are deputed from the Local Self Government Department (LSGD) Engineering wing.
- ❖ The Committee has recommended considering the expansion of the team members of IMPACT, Kerala based on the requirement.

Agenda Item No.8.4: ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION FOR WATER SUPPLY PROJECTS APPROVED UNDER 1st AND 2ND TRANCHES OF SWAP

8th SLTC Decision:

The committee recommended the following to the SHPSC;

- ❖ Issuance of Administrative Sanction for 13 WS projects satisfied the criteria stipulated in the SHPSC for AMRUT 2.0- Cost per household benefitted less than or equal to Rs.50000/- and coverage achieved greater than 75%, amounting to Rs.294.774 Cr. (CAPEX Rs. 279.989 Cr. & OPEX Rs.14.786 Cr.)
- Allocation of additional funds for Mavelikkara Municipality for an amount of Rs. 52 lakhs from the floating fund for WS projects was recommended.

6th SHPSC Decision:(The minutes of the 6th SHPSC meeting is enclosed as Annexure 2)

❖ The Mission Director AMRUT presented the project proposals before the Committee. The committee reviewed the project proposals in detail and accorded the Administrative Sanctions for 12 WS projects amounting to Rs.281.957 Cr. (CAPEX − Rs. 266.873 Cr. & OPEX − Rs.15.084 Cr.)

The Committee accorded the additional fund requirement for Mavelikkara Municipality for an amount of Rs. 52 lakhs from the floating fund for WS projects.

Agenda Item No.8.5: ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION FOR THE SEWERAGE PROJECT OF KOZHIKODE CORPORATION (SWAP-2)

8th SLTC Decision:

The major components of the proposed Sewerage Treatment Plant and Laying Sewerage Network in Kozhikode Corporation were discussed in detail by the committee and recommended to place the following to the SHPSC:

- ❖ Issuance of Administrative Sanction for the sewerage project proposed in Kozhikode Corporation, amounting to Rs.179.29 Cr. (CAPEX − Rs.164.20 Cr. & OPEX − Rs.15.09 Cr.).
- The request of the Kozhikode Corporation to meet the excess amount of Rs. 1.63 Cr. required for the Sewerage Sector from the Water Body Rejuvenation & Park Sector.

6th SHPSC Decision:

- The committee observed that the sewer connections given are only 3128 Nos. and that the cost per connection is Rs. 5.25 Lakh. Therefore, the committee instructed KWA to investigate further and come up with a proposal that could reduce the cost per connection.
- ***** *The Committee deferred the proposal.*

Agenda Item No.8.6: ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION OF REJUVENATION OF WATERBODY PROJECTS APPROVED UNDER SWAP-2

8th SLTC Decision:

- ❖ Issuance of Administrative Sanction for 123projects for Rejuvenation of Water Bodies proposed amounting to Rs. 44.459 Cr. (CAPEX − Rs.41.404 Cr. & OPEX − Rs.3.055 Cr.)
- ❖ The over and above the SAAP amount shall be borne by the ULBs.

6th SHPSC Decision:

- ❖ The Mission Director AMRUT presented the project proposals before the Committee. The committee reviewed the project proposals in detail and accorded Administrative Sanction for 133 projects under the Rejuvenation of Water Bodies, amounting to Rs. 46.665 crores (CAPEX − Rs.43.471 Cr. & OPEX Rs.3.189 Cr.), and the list is attached as Annexure-2.
- ❖ The over and above the SAAP amount shall be borne by the ULBs.
- ❖ Before issuing Technical Sanctions, ULBs shall ensure that the projects should include a nature-based resource management approach that enhances the ecological functions and services of the water bodies. This involves restoring the source of water, increasing the water flow, and improving the water table in the surrounding areas.

8th SLTC Decision:

❖ The Committee approved the Replacement of the project - Construction of a new OHSR of 15 lakh liter capacity at the Fort Kochi tank site for CAPEX Rs.4 Cr with the 5LL CAPACITY GLSR (Ground Level Service Reservoir), pump house, and supply and installation of pump set at Edakochi OHSR for CAPEX Rs.2.496 Cr.

6th SHPSC Decision:

- ❖ The Committee accorded sanction to the cancellation of the project Construction of a new OHSR of 15 lakh litres capacity at the Fort Kochi tank site for Rs.4.15 Cr. (CAPEX − Rs.4 Cr. & OPEX - Rs.0.15 Cr.)
- ❖ The Committee accorded sanction to the replacement project − 5 lakh litres CAPACITY GLSR (Ground Level Service Reservoir), pump house, and supply and installation of pump set at Edakochi OHSR for Rs.2.602 Cr. (CAPEX − Rs.2.496 Cr. & OPEX − Rs.0.106 Cr.)

Action Taken:

Agenda Item No.8.8: O&M STRATEGY FOR STPS PROPOSED BY KWA UNDER AMRUT

8th SLTC Decision:

- ❖ DCE, PIU-2, KWA, informed that the O & M charges for STPs and sewer networks are being met by KWA through the sewer cess levied from the consumers along with the water charges. Recently KWA revised the water charges and the sewer cess. The new tariff has been implemented in only one subdivision out of five in Thiruvananthapuram. The revenue recovered based on the new sewer cess can be assessed only after the new tariff is implemented in all five subdivisions having sewer connections in Thiruvananthapuram.
- ❖ The Committee directed KWA to assess and report the projected revenue recovery based on the implementation of new sewer charges in one subdivision of Thiruvananthapuram and the O & M charges that can be met from them.

Action Taken:

Agenda Item No.8.9: STATUS OF SELECTION OF PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND MANAGEMENT CONSULTANTS (PDMC)

- ❖ The Committee decided to approve the cancellation of the ongoing tender process of PDMC after detailed deliberation.
- ❖ The committee reviewed the revised scope of works of PDMC and suggested for incorporating the task of preparation of DPRs for Sewerage & Septage projects in AMRUT cities.
- The Committee instructed the Mission Director AMRUT to prepare the revised scope of work and the revised RFP for the PDMC and to seek approval from the Government for retendering.

6th SHPSC Decision:

- **The Committee ratified the action in cancelling the original tender process of PDMC.**
- **❖** The Committee took note of the revised scope of works of PDMC and the current status of the tender process.

6th SHPSC Decision:

❖ The Committee accorded permission to the Mission Director AMRUT to engage one GIS expert and one SCADA expert with more than 10 years of experience in GIS/SCADA at Rs. 4,000/day-subject to a maximum of Rs. 40,000/ month on call.

Agenda Item No.9.03: PROGRESS OF AMRUT 2.0

9th SLTC Decision:

The Committee reviewed the progress of AMRUT 2.0. The Chair expressed concern over the slow progress and stressed the need to finish the AMRUT Mission on schedule. MD KWA and ULBs were asked to take urgent steps to issue technical Sanctions for all works of KWA & ULBs before the end of June and to award all the approved projects before the end of July 2023.

6th SHPSC Decision:

- The physical and financial progress of Projects were reviewed by the Committee and directed KWA and ULB to expedite the award of projects and also to submit the remaining DPRs of water supply/ Micro water supply/ rejuvenation of water bodies under Tranches 1&2 before 31st July 2023.

The 4th Apex committee meeting approved the 1st Tranche of the State Water Action Plan (SWAP-1) for an amount of Rs.1938.52 Cr. (CAPEX - Rs.1842.658 Cr. & OPEX - Rs.95.86 Cr.). The 6th Apex committee held on 04.01.2023 approved the 2nd Tranche of the State Water Action Plan for an amount of Rs.683.082 Cr. (CAPEX – Rs.632.658 Cr. & OPEX – Rs.50.424 Cr.

Under AMRUT-2.0, Rs.1813.10 Cr. is allocated for the Water Supply Sector of 93 ULBs. Projects worth Rs.1909.42 Cr, was approved under SWAP-1 & 2 (SWAP-1: Rs.104.63 Cr. and SWAP-2: Rs.385.00 Cr.).

30 proposals (SWAP-3), worth Rs. 234.356 Cr. (Capex), received from 16 ULBs are placed in this SLTC for approval (Annexure-3). The total Central Assistance comes to Rs. 97.07 Cr. The State share and ULB shares are Rs. 88.85 Cr and Rs.63.37 Cr respectively.

The fund allocated to Kozhikode Corporation under the Sewerage & Septage Sector is Rs.163.54 Cr. and they have an unused floating fund of Rs.139.03 Cr. (floating fund allocated - Rs.139.03 Cr). Thus, the total fund available for Kozhikode Corporation is Rs.302.57 Cr., whereas the total amount required for the ULB as per the proposals submitted so far is Rs.332.07 Cr. (Capex). The excess amount required for the ULB is Rs.29.50 Cr.

Agenda Item No. 10.06 : APPROVAL OF STATE WATER ACTION PLAN-TRANCHE III- SWAP-3 PROPOSALS -REJUVENATION OF WATER BODIES AND DEVELOPING GREEN SPACES AND PARKS PROJECTS.

Rejuvenation of water bodies is a significant component under the Mission and 4% of central project funds are allocated for the purpose along with 1% of funds for development of green spaces & parks.

The total outlay of AMRUT 2.0 for 93 Urban Local Bodies in Kerala is calculated as Rs.3495 Cr. with Central Assistance of Rs.1372 Cr.5% of the total fund is allocated for the purpose of Rejuvenation of Water Bodies and Developing Green Spaces and Parks Projects. (Rs.68.6 Cr.).

255 projects for the rejuvenation of Water Bodies worth Rs.82.354 Cr. (CA- Rs. 34.02 Cr.) under Tranche 2 were submitted and the 6th Apex committee held on 04.01.2023 approved the same.

110 projects worth Rs. 54.166(Capex Rs.51.86 Cr. & O & M Rs. 2.301 Cr) under Rejuvenation of Water Bodies have been by submitted on CWAP portal by **35** ULBs under Tranche 3. The total Central Assistance comes to Rs. 20.285 Cr. The State share and ULB shares are Rs. 18.649 Cr and Rs.15.220 Cr respectively.

Agenda Item No.10.07: <u>ADMINISTRATIVE SANCTION FOR 5 WATER SUPPLY PROJECTS (KWA) APPROVED UNDER 1st and 2nd TRANCHES OF SWAP:</u>

As of now, the administrative sanction for 162 WS projects amounting to Rs.1400.863 Cr. (CAPEX) was accorded and Government orders were also issued for the same. The 6th SHPSC accorded Administration Sanction for 14 WS projects amounting to CAPEX – Rs. 318.693 Cr. and awaiting Government orders.

Now 4 ULBs (Thiruvalla, Trippunithura, Thrissur & Kattappana)have submitted 5 WS projects amounting to Rs.8.1192 Cr. (CAPEX – Rs. 7.4492 Cr. & OPEX – Rs.0.67 Cr.) from the remaining approved fund in SWAP 1&2; (Detailed list enclosed as Annexure-5).

Major Components proposed:

- New distribution network- 8.6 KM
- Replacement of existing lines-18 KM
- Transmission network − 2 KM
- Total New connections (FHTCs) 2,550
- Existing Connections served in 62,635
- Total households benefited 65,185

The Unit cost of all the projects falling Below Rs.50000/Households.

Thrissur ULB:

The approval of the project, "*Providing Additional Infrastructure for Laying 800 mm dia DI K9 Pipeline*," for an amount of Rs.1.005 crore (CAPEX: Rs. 1.00 crore and OPEX: Rs. 0.005 crore), was kept on hold by the 9th SLTC meeting for want of proper documents. Thrissur ULB was directed to provide the rationale for the requirement of a new bridge and the condition of the existing bridge, with photographs explaining the same.

Thrissur ULB has reported that the "The existing bridge at Manjakunnu across Manalipuzha, which was built 50 years ago, is in a poor state of repair. It was designed to carry a 700 mm primo pipe, but the new project requires an 800 mm DI pipe. The current bridge pillars have cracks and weak foundations. Therefore, a new bridge with five pillars and a length of 70 m is proposed to replace the old one. **Report with photographs are enclosed as Annexure-6.**

The source is an existing open well which needs to be renovated and rehabilitated. The yield capacity of the well is worked out to be of 53 m3/day (53000/-litre/day). However, state groundwater department has suggested a safe yield criterion of 27000 lit/day. The design storage has been worked out to be 10,000 lit capacity tank. The CAPEX cost worked out is

Rs. 5954748.33 and the OPEX cost worked out is 140993.966. The unit cost has been worked out by considering the CAPEX cost alone is "Rs.54134"/Household.

Rejuvenation of water bodies is a significant component of the Mission and 4% of central project funds are allocated for the purpose along with 1% of funds for the development of green spaces & parks for maximum Central Assistance of 68.60 Crore. A special SWAP of 255 projects for the rejuvenation of Water Bodies worth Rs.82.354 Cr. (CA- Rs. 34.02 Cr.) was submitted and the 6th Apex committee held on 04.01.2023 approved the same.

AS was already issued for 96 Rejuvenation of Water Body projects amounting to Rs.22.654 Cr. (CAPEX – Rs.21.065 Cr. & OPEX - Rs.1.589 Cr.) The 6th SHPSC accorded Administration Sanction for 133 Rejuvenation of Water Body projects amounting to Rs.46.66 Cr. (CAPEX – Rs. 43.606Cr. & OPEX - Rs.3.054 Cr.) and awaiting Government orders.

Panoor Municipality has now submitted a Rejuvenation of Water Body project proposal amounting to Rs. 0.41 crore (CAPEX: Rs. 0.4 crore and OPEX: Rs. 0.01 crore) for the issuance of the Administration Sanction.

As per the AMRUT 2.0 Guidelines Cl.6.9.1, the SHPSC will be competent to approve replacement of projects costing up to 10% of respective tranche of SWAP in admissible project components of AMRUT 2.0. Replacement of projects beyond 10% of respective tranche of SWAP, if approved by SHPSC shall

be sent to the Apex committee with proper justification for consideration and approval. The present proposal is well within 10% of Tranche 2 (Rs. 683.07 Cr.).

Decision to be taken:

❖ The Committee may recommend the cancellation of 23 projects worth 10.996 crore (Capex) with 19 new projects worth Rs. 10.961 crore as replacements.

Agenda Item No.10.11: <u>APPROVAL OF ADDITIONAL WATER SUPPLY PROPOSALS FROM THE ULBs:</u>

Under AMRUT-2.0, Rs.1713.4 Cr. is allocated for the Water supply Sector of 93 AMRUT Cities.

The 1st State level High Powered Committee approved the use of Floating Incentive Fund for Non-AMRUT cities (Central Allocation amount of Rs.50 Cr.) to incentivize those ULBs that show good progress in works and for those ULBs that require additional fund for achieving universal water supply. As such an amount of approximately 100 Cr. was earmarked from the Sewerage fund.

After utilizing approximately Rs. 5 Cr. for the additional requirements of SWAP-1&2, and around 14 Cr. kept for 24X7 WS Projects and SWAP-3 projects, an amount of Rs. 81 Cr. is remaining.

Additional water supply proposals for around Rs.730 Cr. were submitted by 44 AMRUT 2.0 cities. The SMMU team the proposals in consultation with the KWA division offices and ranked them based on the need and fund availability. 34 ULBs were chosen and recommended for an amount of Rs. 193.04 Cr.

(Detailed list enclosed as Annexure-7)

Decision to be taken:

The Committee may verify the proposals and approve the priority list of projects and recommended fund.

Agenda Item No.10.12: O & M STRATEGY FOR STPS PROPOSED BY KWA UNDER AMRUT-2.0:

2nd SHPSC:

Regarding the O & M Cost of projects the 2^{nd} SHPSC decided (Decision No.4) as follows:

- a) The O & M Cost for projects implemented by the ULBs shall be borne by the ULBs and the Secretaries of the ULBs shall ensure that the matter is conveyed to the Council and other related committees of the ULB.
- b) The O & M Cost for projects implemented by KWA shall be borne by KWA as they are collecting water charges and related fees from consumers.

6th SLTC:

In the 6th SLTC the KWA had informed that the O & M cost for water supply projects can be borne by them as water charges are being collected by KWA. For STPs, O&M costs would have to be met by ULB to avoid a financial burden on KWA. In the 6th SLTC the KWA also requested that the O & M strategy being followed for the STP at Muttathara, Thiruvananthapuram, be followed for the STPs proposed under AMRUT-2.0. The 6th SLTC decided (*Decision No.4*) as follows:

After discussions, the Committee directed KWA, TVM ULB & AMRUT to prepare 2 or 3 business models for long-term O & M sustainability for all the cities based on the financial situations of cities, prevailing Tariff, and user-cost recovery (financial) strategy.

8th SLTC:

In the 8th SLTC the KWA submitted the following options in connection with the decision taken by the 6th SLTC of AMRUT-2.0.

- 1) Increase of Sewer Charges to 50% of Water Charges 65% of O & M expenses can be met.
- 2) Increase of Sewer Charges to 70% of Water Charges 85% of O & M expenses can be met.
- 3) Increase of Sewer Charges to 90% of Water Charges 100% of O & M expenses can be met. (Sewer charge at that time was 11.02% of water charges and O & M Charges considered by KWA for calculation was Rs.20/KLD)

The 8th SLTC decided (Decision No.8.9) as follows:

- ❖ The Committee reviewed the current Operation & Maintenance plan for Muttathara STP and the suggested strategies.
- ❖ The Committee instructed KWA to calculate and report the revenue recovery based on the latest approved rates of Sewer charges to the Committee.

This SLTC:

Vide letter no. KWA/ JB/ PIU2/ 10/ JJM-URBAN/ 2021 PART III dated 12.07.2023 (Annexure-8) the Managing Director, KWA, informed that the annual sewerage charges expected to be collected as per the recently revised rates is Rs.19.69 Cr., whereas the combined annual O & M charges for Muttathara, Medical College, Elamkulam & Guruvayur STPs is Rs.13.27 Cr., and the expected savings is Rs.6.42 Cr.

Decision to be Taken:

The Committee may take a suitable decision on the O & M strategy to be adopted for the STPs planned to be implemented under AMRUT-2.0 through KWA.

Mission Director, AMRUT
