ORDER

As per G.O read as 1st paper above, Sanction has been accorded to hire an additional 202 sqm for the functioning of the State Mission Management Unit (SMMU) of AMRUT in the same building where SMMU is working. Sanction was also accorded to arrange requisite modification works for the office space including wall finishing, floor finishing, false ceiling, cabin partition, AC, electrification, plumbing & sanitation, conference table, etc. costing Rs.31,46,944/- (Rupees Thirty-One Lakh Forty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Four only) through the accredited agency, Kerala State Nirmithy Kendra

2. WASH institute plays a pivotal role in the Local Self Government Department (L.S.G.D.) by leading scaling efforts in Faecal Sludge and Septage Management (FSSM) and wastewater management, alongside focusing on knowledge creation, management, and capacity-building interventions. In the meeting with the Additional Chief Secretary, LSGD and the WASH institute held on 05.09.2023, it was decided to allocate space within AMRUT for the technical support unit of WASH institute based in Thiruvananthapuram.

3. Kerala State Nirmithi Kendra prepared a revised estimate accommodating the additional requirement for 18 modular workstations. The revised estimate totals Rs.36,71,370/- (Rupees Thirty-Six Lakh

Seventy-One Thousand Three Hundred and Seventy only), inclusive of 18% GST and Nirmithi proceeded with the revised proposal and successfully completed the work. The funding was provided from the Administrative and Other Expenses (A&OE) funds of AMRUT 2.0

4. Based on the recommendation of 12th SLTC of AMRUT, as per the minutes read as 2nd paper above, 9th SHPSC of AMRUT ratified the actions taken by the Mission Director in carrying out additional workstations and approved the revision of the Administrative Sanction to Rs.36,71,370/- (Rupees Thirty-Six Lakh Seventy-One Thousand Three Hundred and Seventy only), up from Rs.31,46,944/- (Rupees Thirty-One Lakh Forty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Four only)

5. As per the letter read as 3rd paper above, the Mission Director, AMRUT has requested to accord revised sanction based on the decision of 9th SHPSC

6. Government have examined the matter and are pleased to accord revised Administrative Sanction to the modification works for the additional space hired for the functioning of the State Mission Management Unit (SMMU) of AMRUT for an amount of Rs.36,71,370/- (Rupees Thirty-Six Lakh Seventy-One Thousand Three Hundred and Seventy only). Government are also pleased to ratify actions taken by the Mission Director in carrying out additional workstations.
